MUSIC NOTES: John Ellerton (1826-1893) wrote the hymn, "O Father All Creating" January, 29, 1876 at the request of the Duke of Westminster, for the marriage his daughter to the Marquess of Ormonde and published in Thring's *Collection*, 1880 and 1882. Mr. Ellerton's original hymns number about fifty, and nearly every one of these are in common use. The hymn tune AURELIA (meaning "golden") was composed by Samuel S. Wesley, and was originally published as a setting for "Jerusalem the Golden" in *Selection of Psalms and Hymns*, which was compiled by Charles Kemble and Wesley in 1864.
